

# HP 50g Connectivity Kit on Windows 10

Establishing USB connection

## Step 1 – Download the Connectivity Kit

## Step 2 – Install the Connectivity Kit

- Install the software downloaded in Step 1

## Step 3 – Download the USB Drivers

## Step 4 – Install the USB Drivers

- In Windows XP / Vista / 7 simply run the EXE file downloaded in Step 3 to install
- On Windows 8/8.1/10, the USB Drivers will not install until Driver Signature Enforcement has been disabled. To do so:
  1. Click the **Start** menu and select **Settings**.
  2. Click **Update and Security**.
  3. Click on **Recovery**.
  4. Click **Restart now** under **Advanced Startup**.
  5. Click **Troubleshoot**.
  6. Click **Advanced options**.
  7. Click **Startup Settings**.
  8. Click on **Restart**.
  9. The PC restarts, on the options screen pick **7) Disable driver signature enforcement**.
  10. Run the **hpcalculatorusbsetup.exe** file downloaded in Step 3 to install the USB drivers. **NOTE: You will get a warning that Windows can't verify the publisher of the software, you must choose "Install this driver software anyway"**

## Step 5 – Open the Connectivity Kit and Connect
